



NEW! Online Registration System!

YWCA Princeton is thrilled to announce a new Online Registration System for our After School Program at both Princeton and Lawrence locations. This new system means ***no more forms to fill out!*** And online updating of contact info 24/7 and the ability to upload photos.

To ensure a smooth transition to this new system, we need your help! We need parents/guardians of ALL CURRENT After School Program participants to register for an account, enroll their child(ren) and set-up their autopay **by November 20, 2017**.

Here's how: go to the Parent Portal: <https://www.ezchildtrack.com/ywcaprinceton/parent> and click the **Register** button in the third box **New Parents Open Account** (unless you have another child already enrolled in our Young Wonders Child Care Development Center, in which case you already have an account and can use those logon credentials).

You will be prompted to select which Before/After School Program your child is enrolled in (Lawrence or Princeton). Follow the prompts, completing all mandatory fields marked with a red vertical bar. Once you have entered your information, the information for your child(ren), selected the program for your child(ren) and completed the terms and conditions, you will be prompted to enroll in AutoPay. This new system allows you to be charged monthly on a Credit Card or a Bank Account through a secure payment processing system verified by TRUSTe, McAfee, Trustwave, and BBB.

Please note that your child(ren)'s enrollment in this new system will be reflected as 1/1/18. The way you currently pay your monthly charge will continue as it is now through December. You will be charged one cent in this process as a means to verify the payment method that will go into effect in January.
