

The Breast Cancer Resource Center (BCRC) is a program of the non-profit YWCA Princeton. Established in 1972, BCRC is dedicated to providing information and support to women and families affected by breast cancer, and to increasing awareness of the disease in the community.

BCRC programs and services are free of charge and include support groups, peer support networks, survivor retreats, private counseling, a patient assistance fund, a wellness program, a wig & prosthesis bank, a resource library, a guest speaker/teleconference series, and community education activities.
