YWCA supports improving access to quality, affordable, and accessible early childhood programs as a means of reducing barriers to successful workplace participation by women, particularly women of color. Our comprehensive learning curriculum empowers children with culturally sensitive, developmentally-appropriate activities that promote socialemotional learning. The Burke Foundation Early Childhood Center at YWCA Princeton serves children ages 8 weeks to 6 years old.

BREAST CANCER RESOURCE CENTER

YWCA supports improving access to women's health initiatives, thereby empowering women to take control over their physical, mental, and emotional well-being. Our Breast Cancer Resource Center offers support to breast cancer thrivers and survivors, including, support groups, fitness and wellness programs, a wig boutique, transportation assistance to critical medical appointments, and more.

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

YWCA supports immigrant justice because it is integral to racial justice. All immigrants regardless of status—deserve to be safe, healthy, and treated with dignity and respect. English literacy empowers immigrants to advocate for themselves in every aspect of their lives. Our ESL program serves immigrants and adult learners in the Trenton and Princeton areas; we also offer free U.S citizenship preparation classes.

YWCA Princeton founded Stand Against Racism with the former YWCA Trenton in 2007. It has since become a signature campaign of YWCA USA and all YWCAs across the nation. Stand Against Racism is a year-long campaign to unite our voices to educate, promote, and advocate for racial justice. Through this campaign, we invite our community to take a stand with us against racism.

To our YWCA Princeton Community,

My first year as Chief Executive Officer was unforgettable. When I look back on all we've accomplished within the pages of this impact report—which covers July 2020 to June 2021—and beyond, I think of the word "essential." Up until these last two years, I always associated "essential" with notions of who should be on the roads during a snowstorm or the things I'd grab in a fire. But now, "essential" reminds me of my family, my community, and the people in my life who make me feel seen.

Our childcare program only closed briefly during the first few months of the pandemic before reopening at a temporary location. During this time, we were able to complete renovations at The Burke Foundation Early Childhood Center at YWCA Princeton. Early education and childcare were and are considered essential, and for good reasons. But our programs that remain virtual, like our Breast Cancer Resource Center, English as a Second Language, and the YWCA Princeton Area Newcomers and Friends are also essential.

Having access to support groups while navigating any stage of a breast cancer journey is essential. Gaining fluency in English as a means to attaining professional and personal goals, and receiving encouragement and one-on-one support along the way are essential. Connecting with others, learning new skills, and having conversations during an otherwise isolating time are all essential.

Our mission to eliminate racism and empower women is essential. That's why we've pressed on throughout the challenges of the past year. 2022 marks our centennial anniversary, and I am honored to lead this organization into its next chapter. We wouldn't have reached this milestone without the continued support of community partners, our staff, our Board of Directors, and stakeholders like you. **You are essential.** Whether you're a program participant, volunteer, donor, or a fellow advocate, *you are part of our mission in action.*

"My family has attended the YWCA for more than two years now. I continue to see how the curriculum includes age-appropriate skill building in a nurturing and engaging way for all children. I now have two children attending the program. Each of them did not begin their attendance in their infancy but toddler ages. Although each of my children had differences in their development compared to their classmates, it was a short time before they caught up. A huge contribution to this is because of the skilled teachers recognizing where the children should be and helping them to get there. It's not a surprise when your child sings a song from music class or explains how to measure an ingredient or begins counting their fingers. 2021 STAND AGAINST **RACISM: RACISM IS A PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS**

The 2021 YWCA Stand Against Racism theme highlighted the ways in which systemic racism contributes to structural inequities that impact daily life as well as mental and physical health in communities of color. Our Thought-Provoking Talks panel included Past Tribute to Women Honorees Lisa Asare, Assistant Commissioner of Family Health Services at the New Jersey Department of Health and Dr. Nathalie Edmonds, Owner and Director of Mindful and Multicultural Counseling, as well as Ryan Haygood, President and CEO of the New Jersey Institute for Social Justice and Gwendolyn Krol, Vulnerable Population Outreach Coordinator for the Municipality of Princeton.

Our Stand Against Racism Youth Rally and Open Mic was also held virtually, and was attended by students from Plainsboro, Princeton, Trenton, and even Pennsylvania. The students ranged from grades 7–12, and recited original pieces as well as classic works from literary icons such as Maya Angelou and Audre Lorde. Others shared personal stories, or simply words of encouragement.

ASHITA'S STORY

Ashita S. joined the Breast Cancer Resource Center in October of 2020, 6 months after her initial breast cancer diagnosis. It was Stage 2/early Stage 3, triple negative, and she was right in the thick of her treatments. Although it had been a trying journey up unto that point, she was generally doing well physically and emotionally, but upon her initial intake with BCRC Director Melissa, she thought to herself: "why didn't I join earlier?" She attended her very first support group soon after and immediately felt YWCA Princeton was her tribe.

She recalls feeling comfort in opening up and finding support in women who currently are or have been in the same life stage as her and "just get it!" She shares, "As much as it is nice to have social workers, therapists, medical teams, alternate healers and as much as I appreciate and respect them all—you just don't get it till you get it."

Ashita adds the support she has gained from the BCRC has been "life-changing" for both her and her family. She says, "We don't have a history of cancer on either side of the family. Extended family and friends are all geographically dispersed; so BCRC has truly been our one-stop shop." Also noting, "Sometimes it's hard for family to relate, because despite their best intentions they just don't get it. So personally I am able to connect with fellow survivors and just be me, without any judgement."

Although Ashita finds benefit in all of the programing and resources the BCRC offers, our Healing Arts classes are her favorite. She shares: "I found the colors so therapeutic, [our teacher] Danielle is great, and it gives me a chance to both meet my tribe and spend quality mother-daughter time with my 6 year old."

Thank you to all of the donors, staff, and volunteers, whose continued support of the YW and our Breast Cancer Resource Center make it possible to provide resources to women in need right here in our community. Together, we have created a safe space that is Ashita's—and many other's—'go-to'.
