Dear Friends, Members and Supporters,

We proudly present our Annual Report, one that most definitely highlights a year of movement!

Yes, our mission was in motion every day in the form of programs and services that keep us true to our purpose: Eliminating racism and empowering women.

Initiatives like our English as a Second Language Program and Breast Cancer Resource Center once again transformed the passion of our constituency into a continued evolution of growth for many people on many levels. Meanwhile, our multilingual and multicultural nursery school graduated children representing 13 countries and six different languages, all 100% ready for kindergarten!

Our advocacy efforts were far reaching as well. In addition to aligning our organization with the World YWCA on global issues impacting women and girls, we strengthened our relationship with YWCA USA, and joined our sister organizations on Capitol Hill to urge Congress to end sequestration, enact comprehensive immigration reform and stop domestic-related homicides.



Here are the facts everyone affiliated with the YWCA Princeton should know as we reflect upon our current movement:

- **Low-income New Jersey families cannot afford the high cost of sequestration.** For example, 13.3% of New Jersey families are female-headed, and a single mother in the Garden State reaps an average of \$30,707 annually. This means that 43% of are living in poverty. Without childcare subsidies, care for one preschooler costs, on average, 35.7% of a single mother's entire income. Sequester cuts worsen the effects of the recession by driving these families deeper into poverty.
- **The lack of comprehensive immigration reform (CIR) has taken a devastating toll on countless immigrant families.** Across the United States, 1 in 4 women will experience domestic violence in her lifetime. In New Jersey, women make up 51.4% of the immigrant population; a national cap of 10,000 U-Visas limits the number of immigrant survivors of domestic violence and human trafficking who are able to escape abuse. Without CIR, immigrant women are needlessly endangered.
- **From 2001-2010, 280 women were murdered in New Jersey as a result of firearms.** We need to encourage women to trust and work in tandem with law enforcement because New Jersey law authorizes the removal of firearms at the scene of a domestic violence incident, and it also prohibits abusers who have been issued protective orders to purchase or possess a firearm. We live in a region where women frequently cross state lines. We need to create a ripple effect, encouraging other states to follow New Jersey's lead and to work toward zero tolerance of gun violence.

In the words of YWCA USA, we need to work toward a Fearless Future.

Our YWCA Princeton is deeply committed to its mission and every day we encourage women and girls to understand our movement, and become volunteers, mentors, problem solvers and leaders. We directly help families struggling economically by dedicating \$500,000 to \$650,000 of our annual revenue to our Bates Scholarship Program, awarding scholarships to enable families to take advantage of our programs and services.

Our Breast Cancer Resource Center and English as a Second Language Program are looked to by other YWCAs as models of our mission. And while those hallmark programs directly touch thousands of lives each year, that is not all we do. From child care, to after school care and summer camps, to dance and arts & crafts, to book clubs, to educational lectures and seminars, to aquatics, martial arts and wellness classes, to swimming and art programs designed for people with special needs, to a Newcomers Club that welcomes people from all over the world, more than 5,000 participants are personally touched by our programs and services each year!

The YWCA Princeton is governed by volunteers and supported by members and donors. We thank all of you for keeping our YWCA -- and **the movement** for which it stands -- an important cornerstone of our community!

YWCA Princeton has been the heart of a vibrant community, serving Mercer County and Central NJ by providing opportunities that are educational, recreational and inspirational. More than a not-for-profit organization, we are a movement, advocating to eliminate racism and empower women in all we do.

Did you know our YWCA was the first place in our region where a woman could swim in public? And our first racially integrated pool? In fact, our Breast Cancer Resource Center (BCRC) came to be when several women who had experienced mastectomies joined together for a gentle water aquatics program. Today, our BCRC offers a wig and prosthesis boutique, as well as a variety of wellness programs, private and group counseling sessions, community outreach initiatives, a transportation and meal program, and a "pink peddle" bicycle program. Our newest attraction is a Princess Warrior head-shaving program to empower those facing hair loss.

The Nursery School at the YWCA Princeton provides a safe, nurturing environment in which all children can flourish. This past June, our Pre-K graduated 20 children representing 13 countries and six different languages...all 100% ready for Kindergarten. We offer high-quality, specialized care in addition to before and after school day care. Our After School Program in the public schools makes available specialized enrichment programs. And, we offer week-long camps during the spring vacation and winter school breaks.

Our popular Summer Youth Camps offer a variety of exercise, creative fun, and loads of activities. Campers can participate by the week or the entire summer!

Our YWCA embodies a movement where hate is not an option... a place where diversity is embraced... a safe haven where women and their families become empowered.

Special events are held throughout the year such as our magical Cinderella Ball, Father-Daughter Valentine's Dance, Adult Dancing, NJ State Judo Championships, Women's Empowerment Workshops, Women's Equality Day and much more. Our signature events include the annual ETS Firecracker 5K Walk/Run, "In the Pink" Fashion Show, Tribute to Women Awards Dinner, and Crafters' Marketplace. And our Annual Friends Luncheon acknowledges the highly-committed group of volunteers who govern us, and the generous donors who support our vision.

Every day, we encourage women and girls to become volunteers, mentors, thinkers and leaders. 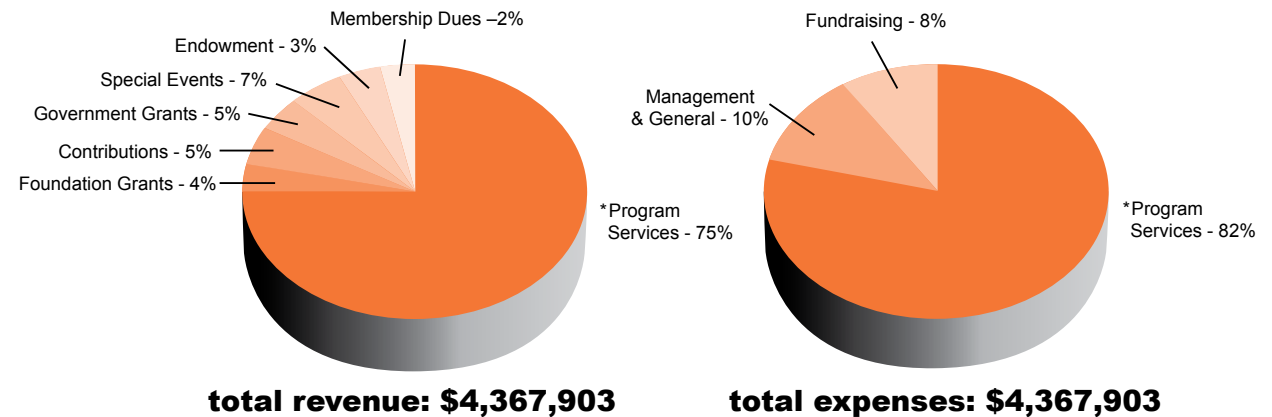
