1922 YWCA National Board grants the YWCA Princeton its charter membership

1930 The Princeton Leisure Time School established by YWCA; now known as Princeton Adult School

1940s Shipped clothing and packages through the YWCA World Emergency Fund overseas to areas devastated by war

1950 Sadie Poulson Dickerson is the first woman of color elected president of the integrated YWCA Princeton

1963 Pearl Bates Scholarship Fund established enabling economically disadvantaged community members to participate in YW programs

1970-73 YWCA Princeton creates Committee for Racial Justice bringing human relations programs into schools, and stands in favor of low-and middle-income housing

In tandem with YWCA USA, we have been heightening awareness of the needs women are facing as healthcare in the United States struggles to resurface from a state of crisis. Locally, we will be working with D&R Greenway to expand our Breast Cancer Resource



Center to 2 Preservation Place. We hope this move will also highlight current theories on how land preservationists and holistic health professionals can work together.

With thanks to our extraordinary donors, we have been able to hire one more full-time employee within our Breast Cancer Resource Center, keep a presence at 59 Paul Robeson Place and unleash the energy of our leaders and volunteers to successfully expand the operations and offerings of our BCRC.

This growth project has also influenced our advocacy work nationally with comprehensive immigration reform and the economy of women and children.

Our vision is to transform parts of Bramwell House into an education and technology center. The benefactors will not only be our English learners and our neighbors seeking citizenship, but also our regional workforce in need of motivated high school graduates.

Meanwhile, we have responded to the call to form competitive All-Girls Robotics teams to participate in the FIRST® Lego League®. Princeton University School of Engineering and Applied Science, Princeton HealthCare System and Princeton Plasma Physics Lab have offered expertise, volunteers and space.

While our hallmark programs directly touch thousands of lives each year, this is not all we do. From child care, to before/after school care and summer camps, to dance and arts & crafts, to book clubs, to educational lectures and seminars, to aquatics, martial arts and wellness classes, to a Newcomers Club that welcomes participants from all over the world, more than 5,000 people walk through our doors each year!



WE ARE EVOLVING OUR ENGLISH LITERACY EFFORTS, WHICH INCLUDE OUR BILINGUAL NURSERY SCHOOL AND ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE PROGRAM. IN MARCH OF 2015, OUR YW BECAME THE FIRST NON-PROFIT IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO BECOME CERTIFIED AS A HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TESTING CENTER. WE ARE NOW ABLE TO OFFER THE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TEST IN BOTH ENGLISH AND SPANISH, THUS STRENGTHENING OUR HSE PREPARATION PROGRAMMING AND CITIZENSHIP CLASSES.

Deep roots and Wide branches — Founded in 1855, the YWCA is the oldest women-led organization in the world that has consistently focused on building women's and girls' leadership and providing community services. The organization has affiliations in 120 countries with 3 million members worldwide and reaches 25 million women and girls through local affiliations like our YWCA in Princeton.

This March, 21 board members of the World YWCA had their general meeting in Princeton. These phenomenal women represented 18 countries and had one agenda: **To envision 2035, when 100 million young women and girls transform power structures to create justice, gender equality and a world without violence and war; leading a sustainable YWCA movement, inclusive of all women.**

They discussed key strategic elements necessary to achieve this goal, and the shifts that need to happen within the YWCA movement. They also discussed the external influences that create opportunities and threats to the YWCA's vision of building a fully inclusive world of peace, justice, health, freedom, and care for the environment.

2004 The St. Nicholas Project is launched, providing holiday presents and food to local families in need

2007 The Stand Against Racism is founded, attracting more than 5,000 participants from 60 organizations rallying against racism and promoting peace, justice, and dignity in communities

2010 "Women's Equality Day Celebration" is launched commemorating the 90th anniversary of 19th Amendment granting women the right to vote

2011 A special exhibit, "Women Changing Lives," highlights extraordinary women whose involvement and support of the YWCA Princeton helped change the lives of women in our community

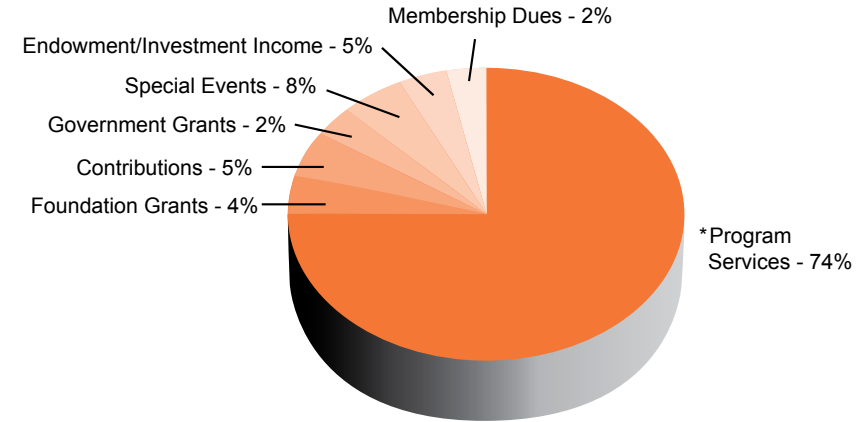

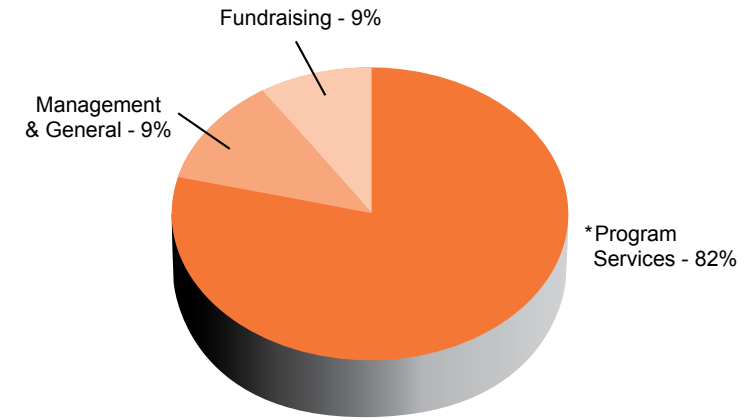
