
2018 YWCA Stand Against Racism Poster Contest

- This contest is open to Princeton area teens who design a poster inspired by the YWCA Stand Against Racism Pledge and/or the 2018 YWCA Stand Against Racism Theme, “ Our Power, Our Mission, Our Future” Full text of the pledge can be found at standagainstracism.org/pledge.
- First prize: \$150, two runners up (if selected) receive \$75 EACH **Participants must be present at the Stand Against Racism rally on Hinds Plaza at 5:00pm on April 27th to win.**
- Winning posters will be exhibited at the YWCA from June-August 2018

Poster guidelines:

1. This competition is open to teens age 13-18 who design a poster meeting the contest criteria.
2. Posters must be submitted by April 27, 2018. They can be submitted in advance to the YWCA Development Office or in person at the event on Hinds Plaza on April 27th no later than 4:30pm.
3. Posters **must** be standard poster size: 22” x 28”
4. Posters **may not** include the following:
 - a. The poster may not contain any nudity or derogatory/defamatory images.
 - b. The poster may not contain any offensive, accusatory nor derogatory/defamatory language.
 - c. All design images must be original and may not infringe upon any copyrighted work.
 - d. Images and language will be accepted at the discretion of YWCA Princeton.
5. By submitting their poster design, participants agree to have their name, likeness and design promoted if they are selected as a contest winner or runner-up.
