## Frequent hand washing

- Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands with soap and water or using alcohol or hand sanitizer

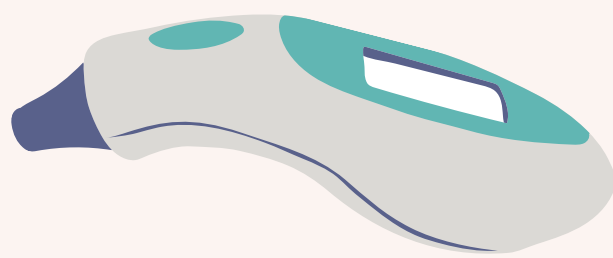


- All surfaces and classrooms will be cleaned frequently



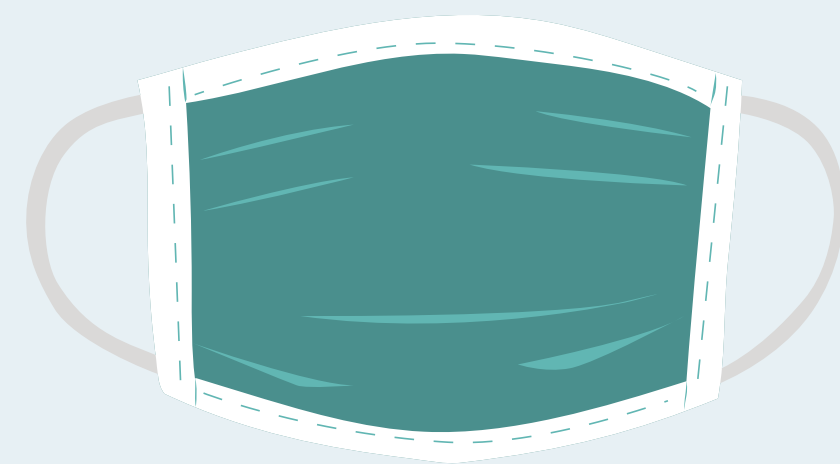
## Daily temperature checks

- Staff and children have their temperatures taken each morning
- Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 will not be admitted



## Personal hygiene

- Masks are highly encouraged by not mandatory for children ages 2-6
- Children and staff will be instructed to avoid touching their faces and cover their mouths when sneezing or coughing



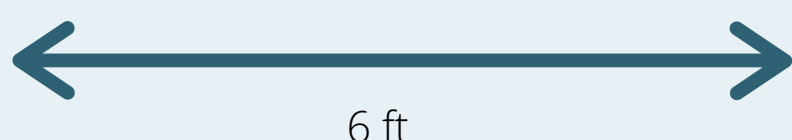
## Symptom screening questions

- Have you had to give your child any fever reducing medication today?
- Have you or anyone in your household been in close contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Have you or anyone in your household displayed any of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath, trouble breathing
- Have you or anyone in your household displayed 2 or more of the following symptoms: headache, fever, muscle pain, chills, repeating shaking with chills, new loss of taste or smell



## Social distancing

- Keep your child home if they are symptomatic
- Pods of 10 students and 2 teachers
- Remain 10 ft away from other pods
- Staggered pick up/drop off

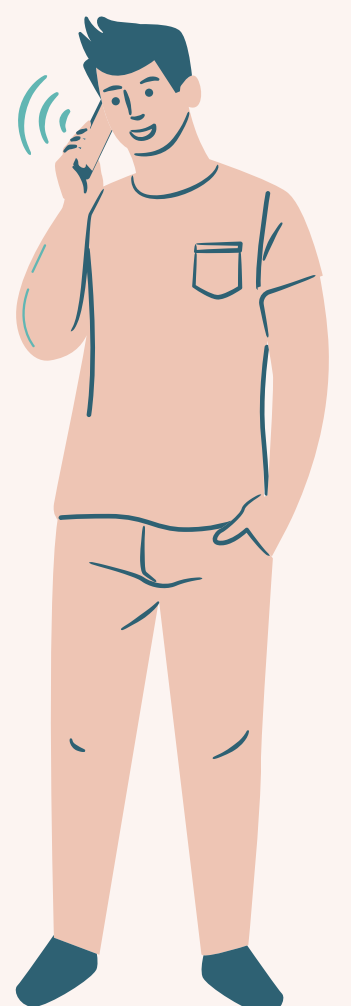

## No parents allowed in the building

- This encourages social distancing and limits potential exposure
