#### Criteria

- ✓ Individual embodies the mission of YWCA Princeton, which is to eliminate racism and empower women;
- ✓ Demonstrates sustained leadership and exceptional talent;
- ✓ Has made significant contributions in their profession and community;
- ✓ Lives or works in *Central or Southern New Jersey region*;

#### Eligibility

- ✓ If selected, honoree MUST be available for the following dates:
  - **Thursday, December 16, 2021** – Honoree Reception at YWCA Princeton (to be held virtually if social distancing still in place);
  - **Early January 2022 (dates TBD)** – Media Day at Riverview Studios, Bordentown, NJ;
  - **Thursday, March 17, 2022** – 2021 Tribute to Women (virtual).
