
The Burke Foundation Early Childhood Center at YWCA Princeton COVID-19 Safety Protocols

As of May 1, 2022, we continue to follow guidelines from the Princeton Health Department in conjunction with NJ Department of Health, the Office of Licensing, and the CDC. This guidance is based on what is currently known about the transmission and severity of COVID-19 and is subject to change as additional information is known. Covid-19 will be reviewed and subject to change for the new school year 22-23.

- Unvaccinated persons who test positive or are a close contact of a person who tests positive must quarantine for 5 days and submit a negative test prior to return OR quarantine for 7 days and no test is required.
- Vaccinated persons who test positive must quarantine for 5 days and submit a negative test prior to return OR quarantine for 7 days and no test is required.
- Vaccinated persons who are a close contact of a person who tests positive do not need to quarantine if they remain asymptomatic and must be tested 5-7 days following the exposure.

Covid-19 Travel Requirement

Children in our childcare must provide a negative test result 1 to 3 days before returning after they or a household member has traveled outside of the Tri-State area (New York, New Jersey, Connecticut), Pennsylvania & Delaware or when someone visiting their household from outside of the Tri-State area, Delaware and Pennsylvania. Only PCR test are acceptable.

Mask Requirements when Dropping off & Picking Up at Childcare Entrance

Masks are not required when parents/authorized persons are picking up or dropping off, unless you are within 6 feet of the entrance door.
